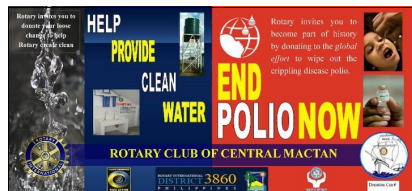

Clubs need to be active working clubs not a social club.

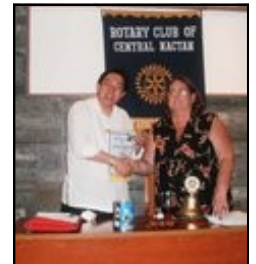
Strong fellowship among Rotarians and meaningful community and international service projects characterize Rotary worldwide.
