Our small, do-able projects will inspire and give hope

Nurturing a child's reading and comprehension skill will have positive impacts throughout a Child's life. This project "Book Donation" was undertaken by the Rotary Club of Central Mactan and was launched this August.

Pictured is the Book turnovers to Maribago, Marigondon & Subu Basa Elementary School. In poor communities, children hardly have access to basic school supplies such as papers, pencils and crayons. This project concentrated on International books Brand New.

RCCM has a BACK TO SCHOOL PROJECT as well that you can be part of.

In the Philippines not all children are given the opportunity to have a basic education. Crippling poverty often means that children are forced to assist the family in making a livelihood and often it's as much not being able to afford the cost of schooling.

We instigated the Back to School project that targeted children that had previously been in school but had dropped out. We offered to support the child going back to school by meeting the cost of schooling and providing supplementary nutritional support directly to the children.

RC Central Mactan is looking for new sponsors and what makes this a great project is that it is very scalable. A sponsor can decide how many children they wish to support in going back to school.

Back to school Project Profiles is aimed to get children back to school that have dropped out do to social or financial problems.

- The program consists of:
- Providing 1 hot meal a day for every school day for 1 year
 - Providing 2 school uniforms per student
 - Providing the required school supplies for 1 school year (per grade)
 - Providing vaccinations such as: measles & tetanus
 - The children who will be helped with this program are chosen by the staff of the schools.

The program will be limited to those schools with needy children, subject to rules and regulations of the Rotary with regards to the 3-year cycle.

• Estimated cost per Pupil per year is as follows:

The money involved with sending 1 child back to school for 1 school year & comes to p17,800 pesos (\$423.81) and receipts will cover this. Based on The current exchange rate p42.

Note: public schools attend 205 days that includes the deduction of holidays and weekends as confirmed by the regional department of education.
